

Bee Friendly Farming® Partner Application Checklist



It should take less than 15 minutes to fill out and submit online if you use the checklist below to prepare the uploads you will need:

List of your organisation's sustainability initiatives.

Partners and beekeepers who manage land for pollinators will be required to supply:

- List and image of forage plants.
- Image of water source for bees.
- Image of nesting habitat.

Beekeepers (apiarists) will be required to supply:

- Apiary registration certificate.
- Photograph of your beehive/s clearly branded with the apiary registration number.
- Certificates obtained from any approved beekeeper pest and disease management courses.

Beekeepers (meloponists) will receive extra credits for supplying evidence of:

- Membership with a native bee club or association.
- Undertaking training courses/ attending conferences on native bees.

You are ready to fill out your BFF PARTNER application. Be sure to allow the form access to your location when prompted, and enter your primary phone number to make future compliance forms much easier; this information is how you will retrieve your application data.

Bee Friendly Farming® Garden Application Checklist



It should take less than 45 minutes to fill out and submit online if you use the checklist below to prepare the uploads you will need:

A list of all known plant species in your garden that provide floral resources (forage) for bees and other pollinators.

Images of your forage habitat.

Images of your clean water sources.

Images of potential bee nesting habitat.

Calculate the size of total land holding and garden habitat area in either ha or square metres.

If you keep honey bees:

A copy of your hive registration certificate.

A photograph of your hive/s showing they are clearly branded with Apiary registration number.

Proof of any pest and disease management training you have undertaken.

If you keep native bees:

List any native bee/stingless bee courses or conferences you have attended.

List any native bee clubs or associations you are a member of.

Pest management protocol, weed management protocol.

Payment via Paypal or credit card on checkout.

You are ready to fill out your certification application. Be sure to allow the form access to your location when prompted, and enter your primary phone number to make future compliance forms much easier; this information is how you will retrieve your application data.

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
